

FFA Forestry Field Day

Contest Rules

1. Send electronic registrations to Andy Seibel, **Information can be found on the Virginia FFA website <http://www.vaffa.org>.**
2. **Log Roll**
Rolling a log by use of peavys and cant hooks. Log size approximately 12 inches in diameter on the small end and 8 to 10 feet in length. Start by rolling log between two upright end for end at the midpoint between the starting and finishing line. Time limit of three (3) minutes. Best time wins. Entries limited to one (1) two-man team per school.
3. **Log Throw**
Throwing a pulpwood stick for distance. Any method of wind up and delivery you can think of that is performed by one person using no artificial devices for assistance. Contestants who wind up by making more than one body turn will be disqualified. Stick size approximately 4 to 6 feet in length. Entries limited to one (1) individual per school. Best distance wins.
4. **Cross-cut Saw**
Two-man team sawing through a log or cant. Bring your own cross-cut saw or use one provided by the Virginia Division of Forestry. Best time wins. Time limit of three (3) minutes. Log size approximately 10 inches in diameter. Entries limited to one (1) two-man team per school.
5. **Water Accuracy**
Squirt water with a back pump (Indian Pump) provided by the Virginia Division of Forestry. #10 tin can placed 15 feet away on a post 4 feet high. Most water in can in one (1) minute time wins. Entries limited to one (1) individual per school.
6. **Bow Saw**
One man sawing through a log or cant. Bring your own saw or use one provided by the Virginia Division of Forestry. Best time wins. Time limit of two (2) minutes. Log size approximately 6 inches in diameter. Entries limited to one (1) individual per school.

NOTE: All equipment will be provided. Individually owned equipment may be used. In past events, teams bringing their own equipment have done better. We encourage each team to bring their own saws. Individuals can participate in only one (1) event in order for team to be eligible for team awards.
