### Purpose:

The Lawn Tractor Operators contest allows participants to safely demonstrate their ability to operate a riding lawn mower. Students are also tested on their knowledge of lawn mower parts and basic maintenance.

### Rules and Guidelines:

1. Each county/club/city is invited to enter **ONE** contestant (limited to the first 25 contestants).
2. Contestants must be between 13 and 18 years of age on January 1st in order to be eligible to compete.
3. Each contestant should bring a clipboard and pencil.
4. In case of a tie for individual awards, ranking will be determined by:

- a. Written Exam
- b. Parts Identification
- c. Obstacle Course
- d. Time

- 5. If electrical storms prevent the driving portion of the contest, then written scores will be used to determine the state winner.
- 6. Contestants are judges on safety at all times while at the contest site: before, during and after their contest operation. At the discretion of the judges, unsafe operation may disqualify a contestant.
- 7. While at the contest, all participants are scored on safety, written quiz, parts identification, lawn and garden operation on the course, and time.
- 8. Any rule or interpretation not covered here is decided by the superintendent and assistants of the contest; their decisions are final.
