Purpose:

The Middle School Ag Exploration event is an introductory contest for new members at the middle school level. The goal of the event is to introduce students to agricultural concepts and to allow them an opportunity to engage in a safe competitive atmosphere.

Rules and Guidelines:

1. Each FFA Chapter is invited to enter up to **three** teams of 3 or 4 individuals.
2. Team ranking is determined by combining the scores of the top three students from each team. All four members are eligible for awards.
3. Contestants must be an active FFA member who is enrolled in an agricultural education course during the school term preceding entry in the contest.
4. Pre-registration is required by September 18th.

5. The purpose of this contest is to demonstrate knowledge of agriculture concepts related to:
 - a. (Every Year) FFA Knowledge: 25 Question Quiz (2 points each, 50 points)
 - b. (Even Years) Ag Technology and Mechanics: 20 ID, 5 Multiple Choice Calculations/Measurement Activities (2 points each, 50 points)
 - c. (Odd Years) Food and Fiber: 25 ID (2 points each, 50 points)
 - d. (Even Years) Plant Science: 25 ID (2 points each, 50 points)
 - e. (Odd Years) Small Animal: 25 ID (2 points each, 50 points)
6. This contest will utilize 6, 12-minute rotations and will be adjusted as needed.
7. Maximum score is 150 points. The tiebreaker will be the quiz score.
8. ID lists and measuring/calculation procedures will follow the Virginia FFA Middle School Event Guide (linked in the reference section).
