

2026 FFA Leadership Camp Dates: July 6-10, 2026

Job Title: Virginia FFA Leadership Camp Staff

Job Purpose: Virginia FFA Camp Staff will support and oversee the successful delivery of FFA Leadership Camp for those in attendance.

Job Responsibilities (not limited to, but include):

- Oversee camp-wide recreation activities including icebreakers, the talent show, quiz bowl contest, and other recreation events. This includes managing sign-ups, communicating details, and ensuring that State FFA Officers are prepared with necessary supplies and expectations.
- Oversee the successful execution of interest classes and leadership workshops, including managing the movement of students during these events and assigning students to the classes (with assistance from the assistant camp director). This also includes ensuring that those leading the classes have the necessary supplies and are thanked in a manner deemed appropriate by staff members.
- Manage the FFA dance, banquet, swim Olympics, fishing tournament and other events.
- Oversee the conduct of leadership events during camp, including the creed speaking event, public speaking events and officer interviews. This includes securing judges for these events, communicating expectations/details to participants/judges, handling sign-ups, creating questions/topics and securing results from judges to recognize students at the appropriate time. It is also the responsibility of this individual to thank judges in a manner that they deem appropriate.

It is the discretion of the camp directors to hire individuals to fulfill certain roles as deemed necessary. For example, an individual may be hired as the recreation director, small group facilitator or leadership director. Specifics of these jobs will be communicated with those who are hired.

Job Qualifications:

- The ability to work successfully and harmoniously with FFA advisors, the camp directors, volunteers, State FFA Officers and others
- Have attended Virginia FFA Leadership Camp previously
- Be over 18 years of age and have graduated from high school
- Availability for the entire week of FFA Camp (staff must arrive on Sunday, July 5 and be available until the afternoon of July 10)
- Successfully pass a background check

Compensation:

The Virginia FFA Leadership Camp will cover lodging and meal expenses for the week of FFA Camp. Additionally, staff will receive a stipend after FFA Camp as set by the camp board.
